Keynote Speakers

Gareth Edwards (Film) - Currently in post-production on his third feature film, the much anticipated *Rogue One: A Star Wars Story*, Gareth Edwards is no stranger to pushing the boundaries of filmmaking. Previous credits include *Godzilla, Monsters* and *Hiroshima*.

Adam Grant (Interactive) - Wharton's top-rated professor and a *New York Times* writer on work and psychology, Grant has been recognized as one of the world's 25 most influential management thinkers, one of the 100 most creative people in business, and named in *Fortune*'s 40 Under 40.

Zane Lowe (Music) - A New Zealand-born radio DJ, live DJ, record producer and television presenter who, after moving to the UK in 1997, came to prominence presenting on XFM and MTV Europe before hosting a new global music show on BBC Radio 1 from 2003–2015.
